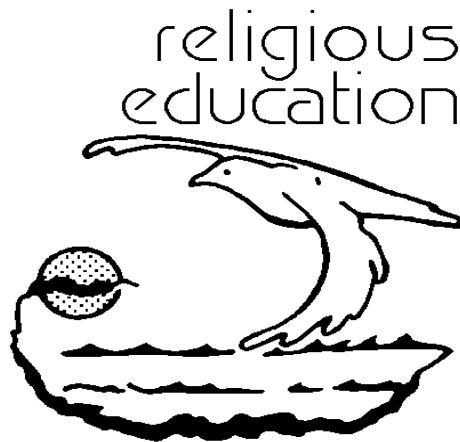

The registration deadline for current parishioners is October 1st.</p>		<p>Grade 10 Confirmation Students: your fall schedule and information packet will be mailed to you soon. Please review it carefully with your parents and mentors.</p> <p>Please read your parish Sunday bulletin each week to note any updates to the CCD Schedule during the school year.</p>	
<p>Students in grades 7-10 will complete the same number of hours as their grade number for Confirmation Service Hours. Hours may be carried over from one year to the next. By the time a 10th grader is Confirmed, they should have completed 34 service hours (7+8+9+10). These service hours should be recorded on special forms provided for this purpose and returned when completed.</p>		<p>*This year: Bring the child/ren directly to Church on evenings of Mass, Teaching Mass, or Penance Service no later than 6:20 pm. Do NOT go to Humphrey Elementary School. At least one parent should attend the Service with your child/ren. Spaces will be reserved for you in Church.</p>	

St. Mary's Religious Education Code of Conduct

Teachers of Religious Education perform an invaluable service to the parents of St. Mary's Parish. Theirs is a time-consuming and challenging job, as you can well imagine. They need to cover volumes of material in just one hour a week and it's often frustrating. Your responsibility as non-teaching parents is to deliver and pick up your young person on time, to discuss with them the content covered in class, and to assure small group leaders of his/her consistent, appropriate behavior.

Our policy states that: **when the adult leader considers a student's behavior to be consistently off task, inappropriate or disrespectful, that student will receive one verbal warning. Any subsequent problem will be reported by phone to the Director of Religious Education. Parents will be contacted before the next class period to choose one of three options:**

- A: Parents may volunteer to teach a group in which their young person is a participant.
- B: Parents will receive leader guides and training to home school their student. A follow-up quiz will be given by the Director of Religious Education.
- C: Parents will accompany their student to his/her class to assist with instruction and behavior.

Parent or Guardian of a Grade 4 – 10 Student: I agree that my young person shall abide by the contract outlined above. I have reviewed it and discussed the contract with my child prior to signing this form. I agree that if my child fails to consistently abide by the Code or engages in a serious infraction of the Code, I will be notified immediately to choose from the options listed above.

Parish Community Service

2. Assist at Parish activities such as breakfasts, dinners, fund raisers. Fall Festival and KC, Lions or Booster events.
3. Teach or assist in Religious Education programs, VBS or Mini-retreats (Grades 1-6).
4. Free babysitting to give parents time together.
5. Teach a child his/her prayers (Grades 1-6).
6. Mentoring a CCD student (Grades 1-6).
7. Straighten books in pews after Mass.
8. Help with seasonal Church decorating.
9. Assist with a Thanksgiving/Christmas Food or Spring/Fall Clothing Drives.

Neighborhood Community Service

1. Free babysitting for needy families.
2. Visiting or helping the elderly and shut-ins.
3. Adopt an elderly person and visit and assist them.
4. Prepare a meal for someone who is sick.
5. Assist with the Ecumenical Food Drives.
6. Assist with KC Breakfasts and events, and/or with Booster events and/or Lions events.
7. Invite an elderly person to lunch or a special program in which you are involved in at school.
8. Visit a sick parishioner or send them a get well card.

Larger Community Service
