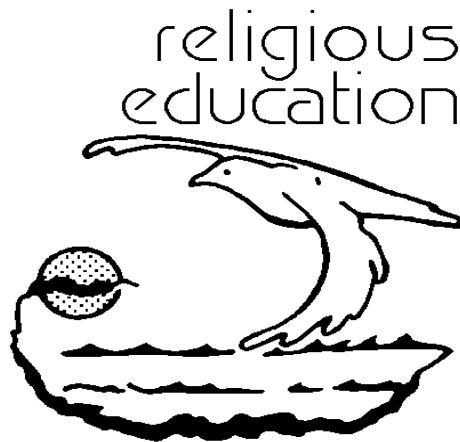

Dear Parents,

We are excited to announce to you and invite you to a new Family Faith Formation Program for children in Grades 1 through 3. In it, parents, children and the parish work in partnership to build and maintain strong Catholic families. The Church's shift in direction is based on the following critical, but long-neglected principles:

- A. As a parent or guardian, yours is the God-given, primary role in nurturing the faith life of your children.
- B. As members of the human family, you and your children will always share the deep internal longing to know God better.
- C. Encountering God in the practice of faith with your children in the surest way to find meaning in your own spiritual life as well.
- D. When the church of the home and the church of the parish work together, LASTING faith formation results.

In addition to fun, quality time with your children, and the opportunity for personal faith growth, other practical benefits include:

1. Completing faith formation activities on your family's schedule.
2. A very minimal cost compared with regular religious education tuition.
3. Only one trip per month into Waverly on Wednesday evenings (unless of course, you have other children in the regular program).

What you need to do next:

- Register your child/ren by printing off the forms from the parish website and returning them along with full payment for your family. Your forms may be returned by mail, delivered to Parish Office or placed in the week-end collection basket.
- You must first be registered in the Parish in order to register for Religious Education. So please stop by the Parish Office if you haven't registered.
- Please read and reflect thoughtfully on the attached informational article (in family mailing).
- Look at the schedule carefully and note the Wednesday evening you will be in Waverly and the weeks you will be teaching your children at home.

The registration deadline for current parishioners is October 1st.</p>		<p>Grade 10 Confirmation Students: your fall schedule and information packet will be mailed to you soon. Please review it carefully with your parents and mentors.</p> <p>Please read your parish Sunday bulletin each week to note any updates to the CCD Schedule during the school year.</p>	
<p>Students in grades 7-10 will complete the same number of hours as their grade number for Confirmation Service Hours. Hours may be carried over from one year to the next. By the time a 10th grader is Confirmed, they should have completed 34 service hours (7+8+9+10). These service hours should be recorded on special forms provided for this purpose and returned when completed.</p>		<p>*This year: Bring the child/ren directly to Church on evenings of Mass, Teaching Mass, or Penance Service no later than 6:20 pm.
